

CITIZENSHIP BY INVESTMENT PROGRAMME

Grenada is a breathtaking volcanic island in the Caribbean made up of one large and six smaller islands. It is famous for its beautiful beaches, lush forests and waterfalls, and for its spice production. Launched in August 2013, the Grenada Citizenship by Investment Programme has become among the most robust Caribbean immigration investment programmes available, designed to drive the country's development through foreign investment. Unique among Caribbean countries, Grenada holds the coveted E-2 treaty visa with the US, enabling citizens to apply for a non-immigrant residence visa and reside there.

Applicants can acquire Grenadian citizenship by making a minimum non-refundable donation of USD 235,000 to the National Transformation Fund (NTF) or an investment of USD 270,000 in government-approved real estate projects. The required investment amount for the NTF increases with the number of dependents included in the application. After five years, the applicant is free to sell the acquired property.

COMMONWEALTH CITIZENSHIP

Grenada's citizens are entitled to special privileges across the British Commonwealth, including the UK.

Grenada's Citizenship by Investment Programme is the only Caribbean CIP to offer access to the US E-2 Treaty Visa.





ACCESS TO AMERICAN MEDICAL EDUCATION

- Applicants must pass due diligence in order to apply for the programme.

- Applicant must not have a criminal record.
